The Finance Committee (yes, there is a committee now!) met on Saturday to discuss and brainstorm about our financial management. Our congregation has dwindled since Covid made its ugly presence felt, and subsequently our giving has fallen off. Unfortunately, our expenses have NOT. As I am sure you are aware, the cost of nearly everything has expanded like a balloon, and I find that we ended the year of 2022 with offerings totaling \$75,918.91, when we needed \$102,429.00. I am sorry to have to write that I have had to pull most of the funds from our other accounts. Happily, the December offerings totaled \$14,881.17, which has gone a long way to bring us to our final total for the year. THANKYOU for that blessing. It helped so much to cover salaries for Judy, Pastor and Vic, and pay the quarterly payroll taxes for the last quarter. This first quarter of the year is the most expensive as it includes taxes in January and at the end of April, along with extra services through Lent.

I am asking you, today, to prayerfully consider our needs for the coming year as you manage your giving to Bethesda. I know that my own giving needs much improvement, and I will be paying better attention to where my funds go. I will try to live up to the 10% that the Lord asks of us.

I know I can count on you all to do your best in these current days of financial difficulty. So, May the Lord bless and keep you, make His face shine upon you and grant you peace.
